- "Make it attractive, make good men wish it were true, and then show that it is" Blaise Pascal

The Power of Eye-Witness

"That which was from the beginning, which we have heard, which we have seen with our eyes, which we have looked at and our hands have touched—this we proclaim concerning The World of Life" – John

time of writing and date of copies.

The Power of Corroborating Historic Evidence

- Merneptah Stele Wall relief inscription in Lux or Egypt dated 1207 B.C. "Israel is laid waste"
- Discovery of the "House of David" and "King of Israel" inscription in 1993 dated from the 9th Century B.C.
 - The dedication stone at Abila and the Lysanias of Luke 3:1
- The stone of Delphi and Gallio the Proconsul of Achaia referred to in Acts 18:12,14

The Power of Embarrassing Details

- "What nation would falsely claim to be enslaved?" (Time, Dec 18, 1995) cf. Ex 1:10-11
 - King David and his adulterous murder (2 Sam 11)
 - Jesus believed to be crazy by his family (Mark 3:20-21)
 - Peter's denial of Christ (Mark 14:17)

• Saul's (Paul) approval of Stephen's execution (Acts 8:1)

The Power of Pre-discovered Scientific Accuracies

- The shape of the earth
- "He sits enthroned above the circle of the earth, and its people are like grasshoppers. He stretches out the heavens like a canopy, and spreads them out like a tent to live in "(Is 40:22)
 - The earth suspended in nothing
- "He spreads out the northern skies over empty space; he suspends the earth over nothing" (Job 26:7)
 - The innumerable stars
- "He took him outside and said, "Look up at the sky and count the stars—if indeed you can count them." Then he said to him, "So shall your offspring[a] be" (Gen 15:5)
 - The existence of valleys in the sea
- "The valleys of the sea were exposed and the foundations of the earth laid bare at the rebuke of the Lord, at the blast of breath from his nostrils" (2 Sam 22:16)
 - The existence of springs and fountains in the seas
- "In the six hundredth year of Noah's life, on the seventeenth day of the second month—on that day all the springs of the great deep burst forth, and the floodgates of the heavens were opened" (Gen 7:11)
- "Now the springs of the deep and the floodgates of the heavens had been closed, and the rain had stopped falling from the sky" (Gen 8:2)
 - The existence of water paths (ocean currents) in the seas
- "The birds in the sky, and the fish in the sea, all that swim the paths of the seas" (Psm 8:8)
 - The hydrologic cycle
- "He wraps up the waters in his clouds, yet the clouds do not burst under their weight" (Job 26:8)
- "He draws up the drops of water, which distill as rain to the streams; the clouds pour down their moisture and abundant showers fall on mankind" (Job 36:27-28)
- "The wind blows to the south and turns to the north; round and round it goes, ever returning on its course. All streams flow into the sea, yet the sea is never full. To the place the streams come from, there they return again" (Ecc 1:6-7)
 - The concept of entropy
- "When the peoples and the kingdoms assemble to worship the Lord. In the course of my life he broke my strength; he cut short my days. So I said: "Do not take me away, my God, in the midst of my days; your years go on through all generations. In the beginning you laid the foundations of the earth, and the heavens are the work of your hands. They will perish, but you remain; they will all wear out like a garment. Like clothing you will change

them and they will be discarded "(Ps 102: 22-26).
